**Starting Classification: U.S. H5/H7 Low Pathogenic Avian Influenza Monitored**

**A. As the NPIP Official State Agency (OSA), Iowa Poultry Association agrees:**

1. To permit the use of the prefix "U.S. H5/H7 AI Monitored" in connection with other official terms in describing, advertising, and selling poultry and poultry products that meet requirements of the 9CFR Section 146 for Commercial Poultry and Section 56 Control of H5/H7 Low Pathogenic Avian Influenza.
2. To direct and supervise flock/slaughter plant testing for H5/H7 LPAI, to develop and maintain a U.S. Department of Agriculture approved diagnostic surveillance program for H5/H7 LPAI; develop and maintain an initial State response and containment plan for H5/H7 LPAI and to perform the administrative work and inspection for which it is responsible in the NPIP.

**B. The member agrees:**

1. To fulfill and maintain all requirements for participation in the NPIP program, in accordance with the National Poultry Improvement Plan and Auxiliary Provisions.
2. To maintain records required by the NPIP and make them available at all time for the purpose of inspection.
3. To participate in the USDA approved diagnostic surveillance program of the OSA submitting representative sample of birds from flock that exhibition unexplained respiratory disease and increased mortality.
4. To comply with NPIP throughout the operating year, or until released by the OSA
5. To participate with all the meat-type chicken, table-egg layer flocks, or turkey flocks that are processed at the members slaughter plant.
6. That the slaughter plan is under continuous inspection by the FSIS of U.S. Department of Agriculture or under the State inspection that the FSIS has recognized as equivalent.
7. To follow the relevant provisions in Title 9 CFR Section 145.53, 146.33 and 146.23 for sample collection and flock monitoring

**C. Cancellation of Agreement:** This agreement is purely voluntary, and shall continue in effect from year to year but may be canceled (1) by the participant upon written notice to the Iowa Poultry Association stating intention to withdraw from participation in the NPIP program, (2) by the Iowa Poultry Association, in its authority as the OSA, at any time upon written notice to the member for violation of regulations.
